- Any individual, group or project is eligible to complete an application for consideration. All applicants should describe how they have performed outstanding service on behalf of others or how their achievements have greatly enhanced the quality of life in the region.
- The application process is open to the community. Preference is given to Realtor® and association members.

- Self-nominating.
- Nomination upon request of the Humanitarian Award Review Committee.
- Nomination made from the community outside the real estate industry.
- An official application form must be completed and submitted for each nominee. Incomplete applications will not be considered or presented to the committee.

- Applications and supporting documentation must be submitted by Sept. 2 to be considered for this year's award. Award nominees will be notified by the foundation's executive director.
