Realtors® Care Day is an initiative of the Charlotte Regional Realtor® Association and its charitable arm, the Housing Opportunity Foundation

WHAT?

As part of its commitment to sustaining affordable workforce housing, the Housing Opportunity Foundation is holding the second annual Realtors® Care Day on April 23, 2010. This all-day, community-wide initiative will assist homeowners with critical exterior home repairs, as well as provide adaptive and safety modifications for the elderly and disabled. Last year, some 700 Realtors® participated to help 30 families and realized a financial impact exceeding \$75,000.

WHEN?

On Friday, April 23, 2009, Realtor® volunteers will work from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. at 30 sites in Mecklenburg and Iredell counties. A Celebration Party will be held at the end of the day for Realtors®, family members from each site location and project sponsors.

WHY?

This project underscores the foundation's commitment to sustainable, safe and affordable workforce housing, and the association's desire to serve the greater community. Each of the homeowners selected for the project will have demonstrated good financial practices but will have also been selected for their critical housing needs. Realtors® Care Day will also provide an opportunity to work with area housing partners to positively impact the living conditions of existing homeowners. These partners include the City of Charlotte's Neighborhood and Business Service Department, Habitat for Humanity of Charlotte, Habitat for Humanity of Iredell County, Habitat for Humanity of Matthews, Our Town Habitat for Humanity, Love, Inc., and the Davidson Housing Coalition's HAMMERS program.

WHO WILL ATTEND?

Some 700 active Realtor® members of the association are expected to volunteer. While volunteer opportunities are not open to the public, the magnitude of the projects involved will require professional assistance from builders, contractors, and other community professionals, such as painters, home inspectors and landscapers. In addition, each participating homeowner and his or her family are expected to take part in the day's activities as they are able.
